

# SPECIAL RULES FOR THE 2020 SWIM SEASON

## Background

COVID-19, also known as the novel coronavirus, is a respiratory illness that is spread through the air via respiratory droplets from an infected person or by touching contaminated surfaces. Pools may be opened but with extra precaution.

## Requirements

Proper pool chemistry and maintenance are essential to preventing the spread of COVID-19 in the pool water and surrounding area. Ensuring social distancing will also be a key factor in preventing the spread of COVID-19.

Sunrise HOA Board has come up with the following rules for the 2020 pool season in order to meet the specific guidelines imposed by the County of Sacramento and largely the State of California.

These pool rules will remain in effect for the ENTIRE 2020 pool season. They are as follows:

1. All swimmers have the option of bringing their own tables and chairs to the pool. By not having community furniture on the pool deck, we are minimizing the risk of contamination. Families will have designated areas to set up chairs and furniture that have been marked for Social Distancing. Each designated area has umbrellas for use. The spots closest to the pool have been designated for sunbathing, therefore do not have an umbrella. We ask that you do not move umbrellas out of their designated locations.
2. All groups must be 10 people or less. Therefore, there will be no approved Group Use requests for the season. There will also not be any HOA sponsored events for the 2020 pool season.
3. Pool sign-in is MANDATORY. If there are a high volume of people and no seating spaces available, please come back at a later time.
4. All pool deck social distancing signage must be followed and adhered to at all times. Please see the attached map below for more info.
5. Masks may be required due to County Guidelines. Whatever the guidelines may be for the County will also be required for the pool area. We ask that you follow any mask requirements as you are traveling through the pool area to the bathrooms or showers when other swimmers are present.

These are the INITIAL rules that the HOA Board has agreed upon in order to open the pool. However, they are subject to change as new issues or guidelines are identified.

**ATTENTION: Privileges may be revoked for the ENTIRE pool season if these guidelines are not followed.**
